It's time to think about the nomination process and encourage members to allow their name to stand for an executive position at the parish level. National CWL has adopted a new requirement, to the nominations and elections process. A pastoral letter of good standing is required for elections for all levels, (i.e., parish, diocesan, provincial and national levels), which is to be signed by the parish priest. To simplify the procedure, a standard form has been developed; "Pastoral Letter of Good Standing Form", which is available on the national website, <u>cwl.ca</u> ... Resources ... Forms (#553)

The member allowing her name to stand for election submits the completed form to the nomination and elections committee, who will verify receipt, the form is then returned to the member.

There are many training workshops available on the national website: cwl.ca. You can use these resources to help members embrace their role as part of the executive, or contact diocesan executive for assistance or to set up a workshop for your council.
